ROAD TRIP

BALLADE EN VILLENEUVOIS



From its source, the Lot valley reveals many treasures in terms of landscape, habitat, interesting visits and gastronomy.

Upstream from Cahors, between Capdenac and Cahors, the Lot winds its way through the limestone hills of the Quercy plateaux. Over the millennia, the river has eroded the karst to create majestic cliffs ranging in colour from white to ochre.

Man has been present in this valley since prehistoric times. In the Middle Ages, villages and castles were built, often perched on rocky spurs, the most famous being Saint-Cirq-Lapopie. These saw wars and better times, notably with the river trade until the early 20° century. Today, most are in a remarkable state of preservation.


Downstream from Cahors, to the west, the hills become gentler, the valley widens, the meanders become rounder and narrower, leaving wide plains suitable for cultivation. This is the terroir of the Cahors vineyards, which cover 4,000 hectares. The vines grow on the alluvial plains, but also on the well-exposed hillsides that give



Cahors wine its distinctive character.

Further west, nestled between plum orchards and the rolling hills of the Pays de Serre, the Grand Villeneuvois entices us to enjoy its mild climate, historic sites and tasty specialities on this weekend in late April.

The Lady of the Lake is a mythical goddess of Arthurian legend, who lived in an enchanted forest inhabited by numerous fairy-like creatures,. Also known as the Viviane fairy, the knights' protector or the water fairy, she shines with her lively spirit and bewitching beauty. She gave King Arthur the sword Excalibur, raised Lancelot of the Lake to knighthood and charmed Merlin the Enchanter. As the village of Monflanquin is deeply influenced by medieval times and has a lake running through it, the view of which you can enjoy from our estate, this nod to the famous Lady of the Lake is an obvious one. After lunch, departure for the fortress of the Dukes of Biron, 25 km from our restaurant.
